TRIP DESCRIPTION

1. Floating Market Muara Kuin Banjarmasin

Muara Kuin Floating Market is a traditional floating market on the river at the mouth of the Barito Kuin, Banjarmasin, South Kalimantan. As the sun rises visit this market that reflects light in the early morning between transaction vegetables and garden produce from the villages along the Barito river.



You can enjoy the atmosphere of floating market together with the society life that live along riverside by the typical atmosphere of Banjar village. Please come in the early morning to see the society busyness so it will become your own experience. The floating market of Muara Kuin is located in the mouth of Kuin river with Barito river and trading activities are started after dawn until 09.00 o'clock. Traders women (hamlet) were boating sells his own produce, while the second hand purchase from the hamlet for resale called "panyambangan" in banjar language

Culinary

You can see many kind of goods like vegetables, fruits, fresh fish, and also culinary. You can rent a boat for go around the river or buy something. By using water motorboat you can see the culture of Banjar society that sell vegetables, cakes, original foods and you can drinks and eat original food and cake from banjarmasin like Soto Banjar.

In around to enjoy floating market, You can rent a boat, which is located along the riverside and you can go around the river or buy something. You can use water motorboat or "kelotok" by the rent price approximately between Rp 50.000,00 - Rp 125.000,00 depending on the numbers of passengers.

Transportation (How To Go There?)

Floating market at the mouth of Kuin river and Barito river can be reached via several routes. The first route from banjarmasin city by using public transport and it

needs 15 minutes only. You can start from Veteran street and then take the route of outwards city. Whereas the second route by using motorboat called kelotok. If you use kelotok boat, from Banjarmasin city to the floating market, it needs one hours. Whereas if you start from bBanjarabaru city to Muara Kuin takes 1 hour.

2. FLOWER ISLAND (PULAU KEMBANG) BANJARMASIN

Pulau Kembang is a habitat for the long-tailed macaques (monkeys) and several species of birds. Pulau Kembang region also is one of the attractions that are in the forest area in Barito Kuala. In the forest area there are altar designated as a place to put the offerings for "keeper" Pulau Kembang symbolized by two



statues tangible white ape (Hanuman), by the community of ethnic Chinese in Indonesia that have specific vows or vows. A male goat horns gilded normally released into the jungle Pulau Kembang if a request is successful or fulfilled.

Called Pulau Kembang because people said island is a delta of Barito river is just a pile of ordinary soil and long growing steadily with more and more soil and then covered with plants that continue to grow, so that the name of the delta into the Pulau Kembang. The island is overgrown with vegetation typical of Borneo, and is currently occupied by a herd of monkeys including the type of long-tailed macaque monkeys alias. And in the middle of the island there is also a king with his larger body.

Administrative area in which the island belongs to Barito Kuala, South Kalimantan, there are places for worship for ethnic Chinese, where there is such a place of worship with a replica of the white monkey / Hanoman. To go to the Flower Island, can rent premises kelotok USD price range. 200,000-300,000. If coming from Syamsudin Noor Airport, travel time to the island of Kembang spent about 2 hours.

3. CAHAYA BUMI SELAMAT MARKET, MARTAPURA

It feels incomplete when on vacation to South Kalimantan without visiting Martapura. Martapura is a city in South Kalimantan which is famous as a producer of gemstones. You can buy a variety of beautiful gemstone creations. In addition to Banjarmasin, there is another city



in South Kalimantan is well known among tourists, namely Martapura. If Banjarmasin is famous as the capital of South Kalimantan Martapura city renowned as a producer of diamond jewels.

This city well suited to be visited by lovers of precious stones. Martapura soil rich in minerals and mining products, making it as a source of diamond jewels. The stones are beautiful, colorful and valuable can be found in various sizes, ranging from soy beans for up to of chicken eggs. No wonder when Martapura dubbed the City of Diamonds. To achieve Martapura, you can use public transport private spent about 40 minutes from the city of Banjarmasin. If coming from Syamsudin Noor Airport, travel time to Martapura relatively brief, lasting approximately 20 minutes.

Diamonds and gem stones in Martapura still mined in the traditional way. Later, the precious stones are formed into a variety of beautiful accessories. Well, for you lovers of precious stones and various processed products, can come directly to the diamond trading center for gems. Martapura, there are two centers of trade of processed gemstones, namely Pasar Batu Market and Light Earth Congratulations. If shopping in both markets, you can find there are many shops that sell a variety of crafts gemstone. Ranging from bracelets, rings, necklaces and earrings can be found at this market. Visitors were free to choose which store to enter. Fun again, buyers can bid on the desired items in accordance with the desired price. Thus, it is possible you will get a price quite skewed here. In addition to gemstones, market visitors can also purchase a variety of traditional crafts in South Kalimantan, such cloth sasirangan.

4. DIAMOND TRADITIONAL MINNING CEMPAKA, BANJARBARU

It turns raw uncut diamond was shaped a lot like ordinary stone. For those who are unfamiliar, this diamond stone may be passed over and is considered completely worthless. And if you've honed and on display in the store, the rough stone could be so valuable. While the trained eye, such as workers in



Cempaka Diamond Panning, then they can sort them from ordinary rock. Although the diamond stone mixed with mud and other rocks. They can tell the difference because it has been panning for years. Panning method here is still very simple. The most advanced tools owned by the miners only form of engine water pump by spraying water into the side of a cliff. If coming from Syamsuddin Noor Airport, the relatively short travel time is about 30 minutes.

Cempaka diamond panning Martapura famous as a producer of diamonds in South Kalimantan. Good Earth Market Light as its diamond trading center. If conditions in the diamond market Martapura has been arranged in the form of kiosks, then at Cempaka Diamond Panning did not like it.

Here you find is hollow ground everywhere with a mound of dirt here and there. The miners here seen covered in mud who worked under the hot sun. However, a variety of beautiful diamond that can be found has displayed neatly in a storefront kiosks in Happy Earth Market Light (Market Intan) Martapura, everything stems from the packing mud Panning Cempaka diamonds.
